

## WILFRED GOODLAND, Private 225814, The Northumberland Regiment Private 203935, The Bedfordshire Regiment

We believe this to be Wilfred Goodland, brother of Ernest – see the previous entry. Wilfred was born on December 3 1881; he was christened at Buckland St Mary on January 1 1882, his parents Henry and Isabella. His father Henry at this point was a Dairyman, and they were living at Woodhayne, Bishopswood. His name is there on all the Goodland family Censuses.

Only one mention of Wilfred Goodland can be found in WW1 records. His Medal Roll Index Card lists two regiments in which he served: Private 225814 in the Northumberland Regiment, then moving to Private 203935 in the Bedfordshire Regiment. Without further information it's difficult to be more precise about his service, or indeed whether this is the correct Wilfred Goodland.

Wilfred is recorded in the 1939 Register for England & Wales, living at Newtown, Buckland St Mary. He is single and his date of birth is correct at December 3 1881. With him is living Mary G Goodland, a widow, born on December 4 1881. She is possibly the widow of Tom Goodland, Wilfred's brother, who'd died in 1938.

Wilfred died in the autumn of 1949, aged 67.
