Harry married Elizabeth Mary Hake on 14 April 1915. He was working as a Railway porter and living at 7 South View Terrace, Trull. He attested on 15 January 1916, and was mobilised on 16 July 1917 into the Labour Corps, stationed at the Southern Command Centre. We know some detail of Harry's military career through his Pension Records, as he had deformed feet - hammer toes and pes cavus (an abnormally high arch) on both feet. He was classified as C2: 'Feet have been bad for some years. Unable to march.'

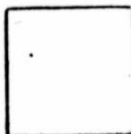
